Meeting Notes

November 7, 2024

Meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm with fifteen members and one guest in attendance.

Treasurer's Report: 40 current members. Report read and accepted.

Secretary's Report: Meeting notes from the October newsletter accepted.

Old Business:

• The new shed (CONEX) was delivered and set in place on November 1st. Many thanks to those of you who volunteered to be on site to assist in the delivery. Total costs to date have been below the amount approved for the project, but we still need to purchase a ramp and paint for the outside.

New Business:

- Field Clean-up will be conducted Saturday, November 9th. Not a lot to do, so it should be fairly quick.
- There have been reports of some non-members parking on the field access road. We may need to take additional steps (more signage, or other) to ensure our access is not blocked.
- Elections: Mark Thom has been voted in as our next president. Ken Kennedy will remain as secretary and newsletter editor. Frank O'Neil will remain vice president, and Don Chase will remain treasurer. Dean Allred is going to take over as Safety Coordinator. The Board of Directors (Jim Tilton, John Backhaus, Mike Larson) will remain the same. Voting was unanimous and since a quorum was present, is effective immediately.

Discussion:

- Many AMA licenses expire December 31st. Don't forget to renew. In addition, make sure your FAA license
 has been renewed (3-year license) and is valid for next year. Please note the FAA requirement is an *individual responsibility*, and the club is *not* in the business of enforcing the rule.
- Visitor Ron St. Germain (president of the Northeast R/C Model Club) discussed some of the initiatives they have put in place to draw new (younger) members to the club.
- A suggestion was made that we install another small sign on the airfield gate with a QR code that linked to a YouTube video that demonstrates several aspects of the hobby. Many new visitors from the rail trail.
- Another suggestion was to mount a locked cabinet in the new CONEX to house a trainer plane and transmitter. Walk-in guests who are interested in "trying it out" could then be given a buddy-box flight if an instructor is present. This would be good from both a public relations and potential new members standpoint.
- We should look at contacting the local Boy Scout troop to see if they would be interested in a class and introductory flight next year. It was mentioned that this could fulfill requirements for the aviation merit badge.
